Fees : All matches \$15, juniors \$7.50

Time of Firing: 0800 hrs.

Squadding : Individual matches will be squadded prior to the match.

Classification: NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class. Assigned and temporary classification may be used. F-Class will fire in a separate class.

Pit Service : provided by the competitor.

Challenges: \$1 will be charged for lost challenges. Scores can be challenged only prior to awards.

Rifles : Any Rifle Iron sight -Rule 3.2;Palma – Rule 3.3.3; or service rifle -Rule 3.1,.3.1.1, or 3.1.2. AROS-Any Rifle Optics Sling – separate category from F. F-Class – Rule 3.4(a) and (b) may use scopes, rests and non-Magnum calibers. F-O, F-T/R

Sights: Metallic only - Rule 3.7a, F-Class is not limited. AROS – optics w/sling

Targets: 300 yd-MR-63; 600 yd - MR-1; F-class:300 yd-MR-63FC; 600 yd-MR-1FC

Ammunition: Furnished by competitor, no tracers or AP.

Coaching : Allowed during the firing of any matches for juniors and new shooters.

Sighting Shots: 2 / MATCH - fired and scored in the individual matches.

Course of Fire: order of firing may vary (i.e. 600 may be first due to afternoon light conditions).

Match 1 - 20 record - prone slow fire, 300 yds, MR63 / MR63F

Match 2 and 3 - 20 record – prone slow fire,600 yds, MR-1 / MR-1FC target. Rule 5.6

Match 4 - 60 shot aggregate

Awards

Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match. Number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Marksman and Sharpshooter require 3, all others require 5. Additional awards will be given for each additional 4 competitors. Classes will be combined upward as required. High Master class will not be combined - if less than 5, they fire for the open awards only. **F-class will be a separate category and must have at least 5 before agg. award will be given. F-O and F-TR will not be combined.**

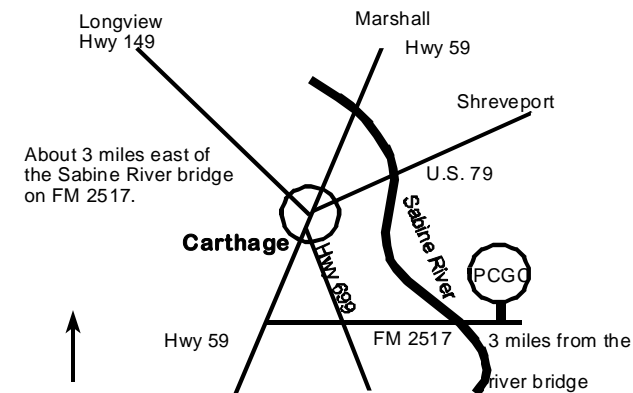
