**Registration:** Registration and entry fees must be received by March 26, 2009. Mail entry form and fees to Ken Gaby, 52 Branding Iron Dr, Belton, TX 76513, phone (254) 780-2025. Advance entry is highly encouraged to facilitate computer entry, squadding and securing your entry before this tournament fills to range capacity of 124. Post-entries accepted up to range capacity. A \$10.00 fee will be charged for post-entry.

**Range Location:** From Bastrop, go north 8 miles on Hwy 95. From Elgin, go south 8.4 miles on Hwy 95. The base is on the east side of the highway.

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be individual members of the NRA or their country's national organization and TSRA. Competitors must complete a TSRA membership application before squadding if not already a TSRA member. Non-residents of Texas may purchase a match membership for \$10. Statistical Officer may ask for proof of NRA/TSRA membership and/or classification.

**Refunds:** Three-fourths of entry-fee refunded provided notification made by 3pm, March 25, 2009. No-shows will not be refunded.

**Daily Start Times:** Matches begin at 0800, pits sealed at 0745 hours.

**Rules:** Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules apply.

**Classification:** NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Assigned classifications for High Power will be used if the competitor does not have a mid-range classification. Smallbore classification will be used if the competitor does not have a high power classification. This 120 shot tournament will establish a mid-range classification.

**Pit Service:** Each competitor will be required to serve in the pits. **Eye protection is required in the pits.** Seniors or competitors not physically able to pull targets may provide qualified pullers in their place with pre-arranged approval of Match Director. Hired pullers may pull for only one competitor at a time. Be prepared to present documentation per NRA Rules. Children and non-competitors are not allowed in the pits.

**Scoring:** Competitors will score during all matches. Scorecards are to be turned in by scorekeepers following the competition of firing of each individual match. A scorer failing to turn in a score card may result in disqualification. **Score Card Changes:** Changes or erasures without scorer's initials can disqualify competitor for that match.

**Challenges:** \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge but will be refunded if challenge is sustained. A schedule will be posted of challenge times. All scores and awards are tentative until publication of the final bulletin. Competitors should notify the Statistical Officer of any apparent errors.

**Equipment:** As appropriate for each individual match according to the most current NRA rules of competition.

**Ammunition:** Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. AP, Tracer, and/or incendiary ammunition will not be permitted.

**Coaching:** Coaching will not be allowed except for juniors.

**Targets:** NRA approved MR-63, MR-63FC, MR-65, MR-65FC, MR-1, MR-1FC bulls eye targets will be used.

**Safety:** Safety will be paramount in all activities! All rifles will have actions open with clips/magazines removed and an empty chamber indicator inserted into the chamber of the rifle except when on the line during prep period or during firing. Handling of rifles and policing of brass (collection of brass forward of the firing line) will only be permitted at the direction of the Chief Range officer.

**Range Rules:** Persons appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed on the range. Children, juniors and pets must be controlled and shall be the responsibility of their sponsors. Parking will be in designated areas only. Anyone violating these rules will be denied range privileges. Other action may be taken where deemed necessary.

**Sporting Rifle:** Competitors wishing to shoot a scoped rifle without a front or rear rest are encouraged to enter and will shoot in a separate category.

**Awards Schedule:** Matches 4,8,9: trophies and/or checks will be awarded to the match winners; category and class awards will be checks. One award will be given per five entries in each category/class not to exceed three awards per classification. In the event there are less than three competitors in a class, the class will be combined upward. Unclassified competitors will compete in a separate class/category for awards only. Special category awards for: High Senior, High Woman, High Junior. A TSRA Mid Range Champion will be awarded for Match Rifle, Service Rifle, Palma Rifle, F/TR and F/O.

**Firing Sequence:** Due to time constraints for range use, firing order of matches may be altered by the Match Director to facilitate an earlier conclusion each day.

Match 1 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 300yds

Match 2 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 500yds

Match 3 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 600yds

Match 4 Aggregate of matches 1 thru 3

**Sunday March 29**

Match 5 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 300yds

Match 6 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 500yds

Match 7 Two sighting shots and 20 rounds for record @ 600yds

Match 8 Aggregate of matches 5-7

Match 9 **Grand Aggregate of matches 4 and 8 TSRA Championships awarded based on Match 9 scores.**
