We had a great weekend for shooting as 40 shooters vied for a number of titles with their WWII firearms. Thanks to the Temple Gun Club for hosting the event and making the match a success. Sometimes we forget the fun part of shooting but after matches like these, it is obvious that there is still fun to be had. The shooters ranged from nationally ranked high power rifle shooters to the first time entrant but the fun meter was pegged for everyone. Even when the first blast of autumn blew through and dropped the temperatures with it's cold breezes, everyone was thankful for a break from the summers heat.

The Garand match was won by David Guthery of Gorman as he fired a strong score of 284-4x on the first relay of the match. Don Tryce of Austin picked up his 1903A3 Springfield and proved that a lefty can handle one of these vintage rifles firing a winning score of 278-2x to edge out Bill Aten's 277-4x. Sunday saw the carbine match winner crowned as Louis Lamereaux of Austin (262-5x) slip past Robert Langham (261-1x) with is famous carbine. You know, the "good" one that shoots good, doesn't seem to be too many of them around. The final relay of the weekend provided the vintage rifle winner as Robert Langham of Tyler fired his Swiss K-31 with outstanding prone scores.

We had 40 Garand shooters, 19 Springfields, 17 carbines and 9 vintage rifles fired with many shooters re-entering multiple times.

Again, thanks to Losson Rogers, Bobby Law and Ken Gaby of the Temple Gun Club for their support and help in making this match a success. The TSRA service rifle team has supported this match and have used it as a fund raiser to help with the cost of fielding a team for Camp Perry each year. Getting a competitive team prepared for Perry requires a considerable amount of practice and ammo, these funds go directly into this training fund. Thanks for your support and don't pack those rifles away, continue bringing them out to the local matches and keep them limbered up.
