In the combined Expert/Sharpshooter class, Robert Langham continued to pour it on those guys with a score of 466-7x. Second time shooter, Brett Neyland, was the Marksman class winner with a solid 444, there are good things coming for him.

We had 6 new shooters in Master unclassified and from the sounds they were making, we should be seeing them again. It is good to see the new shooters on the firing line. Now all we need is to attract some younger ones. But these will do in a pinch.
