

CMP Service Pistol Match Program May 3, 2009

1. Panola County Gun Club – EIC match - Pistol
Carthage, TX 5/3/2009
2. Location: East from Carthage on FM 2517, three miles east of the Sabine River.

4. Range capacity is 30 shooters. The match will begin at approximately 1300 hr. or as soon as practical following the rifle match.
5. Conditions governing the match :
 - A. Rules of this match are governed by the rules prescribed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program otherwise NRA rules apply.
 - B. Open to any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older. (Distinguished personnel are eligible to compete, however, if range facilities limit the number of entries which can be accepted, priority will be given to non-distinguished competitors.)
 - C. Course of Fire: CMP Service Pistol Match (National Match Course)
First stage- Slow fire, 50 yards, 10 shot string in 10 minutes.

Second stage- Timed fire, 25 yards, 2x 5 shot strings, 20 seconds each.

Third stage- Rapid fire, 25 yards, 2x 5 shot strings, 10 seconds each.
 - D. Arms: 1911 type (CMP 6.4.1) or Beretta M9 type (CMP 6.4.2). Loaner pistols will be available for those without an appropriate pistol. **More than one competitor may use the same pistol if squadding permits. Notification of the need for special squadding must be made prior to the match.**

Check the CMP rules as to the appropriate configuration of the pistols that may be used. 1911 type pistols can NOT have beavertail grip safety, forward grooves on the slide, bobbed or Commander style hammer, extended slide stop or safety or ambidextrous safety.
 - E. Ammunition: .45 cal. - Any safe ammunition with 230 gr. FMJ round nosed bullets may be used. 9mm – Any safe ammunition with 115 to 125 gr. FMJ round nosed bullets may be used. Competitors are required to furnish their own ammunition but loaner pistols will be fired with purchased provided or commercial ammo.
6. Awarding of place medals, leg points and distinguished medals will be by the CMP.
